



Former employee of Holiday Lanes, Drue Smith passed away on April 4, 2015 after a seven year battle with cancer.

Drue met his wife, Pilar while stationed in Madrid Spain. They married on April 3, 1961 and had just celebrated their 54th wedding anniversary the day before his passing. After moving several times throughout Europe with the military they were stationed at Barksdale Air Force Base in 1969 and made Bossier City their permanent home. Drue and Pilar began bowling at Holiday Lanes in 1969 and were a regular fixture there for over 50 years, always together bowling several days a week. Their children and their children's children were raised at the bowling alley. Drue loved bowling and forged many friendships over the years. He loved bowling so much that after his second retirement from the US Federal Courts, he began working at Holiday Lanes and worked until his treatments prevented him from being able to continue. He continued bowling as much as he could. Any time he underwent treatments or had a bad episode, he always asked the doctor "Doc, can I bowl". If the doctor told him he could, then you could bet Drue would be at the bowling alley giving it everything he had. He bowled until he was just no longer able to do so, but bowling was always in his thoughts. Pilar continues bowling to this day.

A lot of you may not know Drue, but the majority of you have probably been touched by cancer in some way. Whether you yourself suffered cancer and survived (God Bless You) or you had a friend or family member you witnessed suffering from this disease you know cancer knows no boundaries. It doesn't discriminate between young or old, black or white, man or woman.
